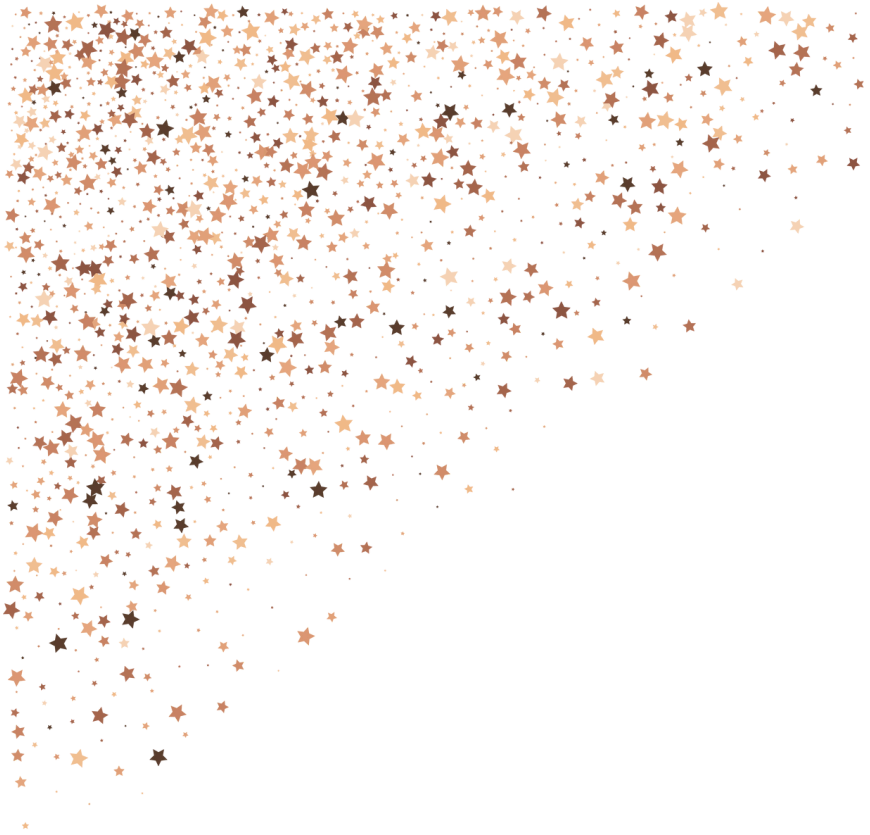

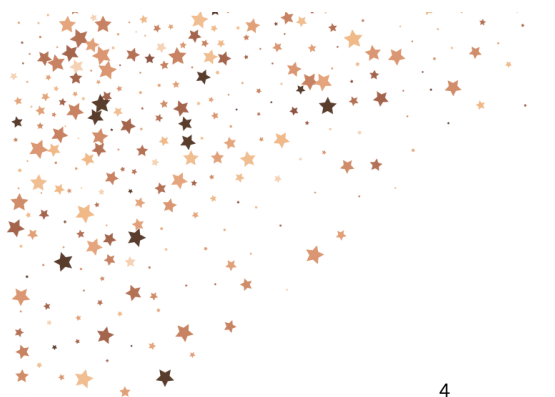

“Writers are the custodians of memory,” wrote noted scholar and author William Zinsser.

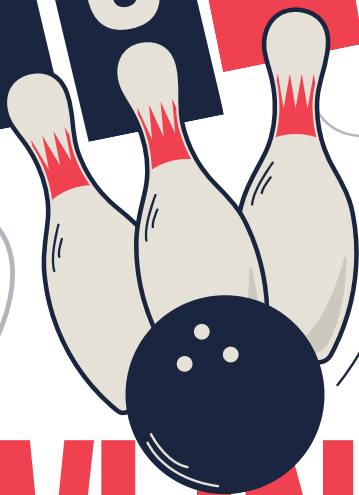
